SD23 budget presentation - 80% of our funds go to running classrooms (supplies and staff)

- All of our grad rates are above provincial average (all students, inclusive ed, and Indigenous grads)
- District is still growing
- Approx. 4500 staff
- 383m dollar budget for 2024/25
- 2500 children in childcare through our district
- Expecting a 100 student growth for next year
- Meetings for budget prep are public and anyone can attend

Tristee Val Johnson - Hockey skill academy increases for many schools (incl. RSS)

- Feedback on budget survey will be looked at including comments
- Looking for new superintendent

Kevin Kardall - Semester 2 and basketball is off and running

- Some different news in the province with the Victoria school board being fired by the minister over the cancelling of the school liaison program - lone trustee in place until Fall 2026 (next elections)
