# TREASURER's REPORT - Adrian Burton to Report

- Account update
  - General Account \$9,057.72 (this amount is inflated as payments to hot lunch for two months worth of lunches to vendors needs to be paid)
    - Purdy's \$757.05 (profit)
    - Cookie Dough approx \$1000 (profit)
    - Basil Cooper \$500 (profit)
  - Gaming Account \$8,868.20

### **HOT LUNCH REPORT**

- Profit Total YTD \$963.96 (approx \$200/month)
- Hot Lunch isn't generating the profit the PAC was anticipating
  - Trying to change ordering dates end up chasing parents for payment
  - o Looking forward how do we increase revenue as previous years hot lunch was the main revenue
  - With the school store (Snack Shack) up and running is the administrative commitment worth it?
  - Can we start bottle drives? RMS band has the monopoly on bottle drives
  - Ask at the COPAC meeting how do the other school's fundraise (Becky Ingbritson to bring forward)
  - Going forward hot lunches will be picked up from the cafeteria (announcement will be done before lunch time)

# COPAC REPORT (resource - www.copac.sd23.bc.ca) - Becky Ingbritson to Report

- Will bring forward questions/inquiry about hot lunch
- COPAC is recruiting for their executive
- Some PAC funded purchases are eligible for PST refund; you can also look at retroactively apply up to 4yrs; check with the school on whether the school as submitted the PST refund
- Can SD23 employees be on PAC's? will look into, look into Bylaws and Constitutions as per Kaylyn's memory there is nothing that depicts that they cannot
- Food Guidelines/recommendations about what can be served/sold in school stores

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Fencing RMS PAC agreed to only pay \$1500
- YEAR END Celebration (a day for each grade)
  - Last year's costs PAC only funded rental of the equipment (\$5765), school funded the cost of the food (\$1132); this year we have been asked to fund both (approx \$6800)
  - Notion put forth by Marina Hailey to vote to spend up to \$7000 on RMS YEAR END CELEBRATION (both the food and the equipment); 2nd: Jennifer Gelz
    - Unanimous decision was YES

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- What fundraisers are we interested in doing over the next 6months?
  - FunRaizin Fundraiser is a go!
    - Multiple media related items to buy (power cords, speakers, etc)
    - Display will be made in display box at school/posters/flyers
    - Online purchasing, home delivery, 50% profit goes to PAC
- One funding request fill a cart with lego for the RMS library
  - Tabled until September meeting
- RMS Spiritwear
  - We will shift to a new vendor for next year BC Sportswear (Kyle)
    - Next run will be at the beginning of the 2022-23 school year will time distribution for the end of Sept timed with a SPIRIT DAY
    - Looking at more basic/simple product
    - Evolving price point the more you buy the cheaper the product
