Troy White - Personal Digital Device Restrictions for Students - met with parents through COPAC

- Intention Promotes online safety and focused learning environments
- Not a full ban restriction, bell to bell
- Any device with the ability to access the internet including school devices or communicate
- Our students will secure and power off any devices during class time and non class time (breaks and lunches) at all elementary and middle school level
- secure and power off any devices during instructional time unless directed by a staff member
- No device use where students can expect privacy (bathrooms/changerooms)

Policy will be posted on the district site

- Trustees report 10.5 million for addition to Chief Tomat
 - Kelowna RCMP integrated child exploitation unit gave a report that was pretty eye opening for the board (1-3 calls per week about online exploitation)
- Superintendent lots of celebrations coming up
- COTA focused on the end of the year
- CUPE everyone is hugely busy
- Teacher emails no longer available on websites creates challenges with contacting teachers can always call/email office to get in touch
- COPAC will have PAC 101 and treasurer 101 in September/October
- Did we deposit the \$75 cheque?
- Many PACs are planning to sign proxies next year again for BCCPAC even if the fees are not covered by the district/COPAC - gaming account is eligible to be used
- Proposed budget is to pay again but this is very far from set in stone
