SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION FOR 2017-2018

No seats have been reserved for the 2017 - 2018 bussing service. Please follow the steps below to apply to use the school bus service.

All parents are required to apply for bussing each year. Please use the link below to apply for bussing:

https://transportation.sd23.bc.ca/

Payment will not be required at this time, you will be sent a payment link once a seat has been assigned.

In cases of financial hardship, application for subsidy can be made through your school Principal, once you receive a seat confirmation.

NOTE: Early registration and payment of at least the 1st installment of the Student Transportation charge by June 30th will result in a discount of at least \$30 per child.

All confirmed riders, who have arranged for the \$280.00 Student Transportation Charge and received their electronic bus pass with their stop information, should still refer to the Transportation Website after August 30th, for up to date route information, as stop information can change once a pass is issued.

Please note that seats for courtesy riders may not be confirmed until August 1st.

Students must be registered riders with bus passes to ride a school bus.

SEPTEMBER 2017 SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION FOR 2017-2018

Parents, guardians, and students are reminded that students must be registered riders with bus passes in order to ride the school bus. Friends and clients of afterschool care are not eligible for school bus service at any time during the year unless they are registered riders. Alternate forms of transportation need to be arranged for after school social plans and daycare arrangements. In cases of financial hardship, application for subsidy shall be through your school Principal. This is a good time to review the safety rules for bus riders. Due to the volume of applications for courtesy rides, it may not be possible to contact each applicant individually. If you have not had a courtesy application confirmed by October 15th, it may mean that there are no additional seats available. However, if you believe that there is space still available on a school bus passing through your neighborhood, please contact Transportation at (250) 870-5151. Phone lines are open between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm Monday through Friday.

Please note that courtesy seats are subject to cancellation at a week's notice should seats be needed for additional eligible riders.
