## PRINCIPAL's REPORT - Provided by Rod Baruta and James Geen

- Kick off of Multicultural week talk and visit held in Auditorium connecting with different members of the school, sharing cultural traditions, experiences, transitions to Canada
- First (Term 1) Enrichment is wrapping up second Enrichment (Term 2) selections to start the first week in December will start in January 2023 (approx Jan 11th)
- Several activities coming up in the month of December potential dance, spirit days more communication about the upcoming events will be delivered via the VOODOO news
- Term 1 report cards will be headed out to the families in early December the evaluation of student learning is changing - this year is a test/pilot year - next year (2023-23) the entire province will report the same
  - Evaluation will be done as Strength based learning language
  - History what do parents, teachers, COPAC want to know about their students learning evaluation - what do you want from the report cards??
    - HUGE focus on evaluating the STRENGTH of the student, core competencies as a learner
       looking at and reflecting on how the student applies and approaches their work
    - Using language that is easy to understand, more concise
    - Looking at the academia of the student and how they contribute to the greater whole to society - looking at the holistic person, creating a balance between academia and personality

- School district received Government grants
  - School Based Teams (SBT) are looking at the RMS families and how we can reach out and help these families with the financial burdens that are upon us with the Christmas season coming upon us.
    - An invitation for the RMS families to contact Rod or James if they are aware of families that are in need
